Erin Beaudoin is a passionate advocate for people living with dementia and caregivers. Currently serving as the Chief Operations Officer for the Vancouver Island Real Estate Board, she brings extensive leadership experience to her advocacy efforts.

As the former Executive Director of Eden Gardens, Erin led 240 health-care professionals who provided compassionate, person-centered care to 130 seniors living with dementia at Eden Gardens and over 500 people in the community through programs. She is a strong proponent of "The Eden Philosophy," which advocates for fostering environments that prioritize personhood and dignity for people affected by dementia.

Erin's advocacy extends through her active involvement with the Technical Advisory Board of SafeCare BC, as Vice President of the BC Care Providers Association and as a Subject Matter Expert with the Family Caregivers of BC.
