

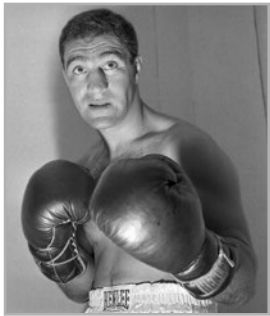

On This Date

1956 – Undefeated heavyweight champion Rocky Marciano stunned the sports world by announcing his retirement at age 32 to spend more time with his family. Marciano walked away with a perfect 49–0 record.



1967 – The opening ceremonies for the 1967 International and Universal Exposition, also known as Expo 67, were held in Montreal. The invitation-only event was held at Place des Nations. The fair opened to the public the following day, welcoming over 50 million visitors and showcasing futuristic architecture like Habitat 67.

2006 – Construction began on the Freedom Tower, the signature skyscraper of the new World Trade Center. Now known as One World Trade Center, the tower is a symbol of renewal and resilience.

Happy Birthday!

Casey Kasem (1932–2014) was an American radio personality, actor, and voice actor whose upbeat spirit and unmistakable tone made him one of the top voices in show business. He became a cultural fixture as the host of *American Top 40*, the syndicated radio countdown show he created in 1970.

Beyond radio, Kasem enjoyed a prolific career as a voice actor, most notably as the first actor to voice Shaggy in the *Scooby-Doo* franchise.

His contributions to broadcasting earned Kasem induction into the National Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame in 1985 and the Radio Hall of Fame in 1992. Off the air, Kasem was a devoted family man and passionate advocate for animal rights.
