1746 – Flora MacDonald helped Bonnie Prince Charlie evade capture by disguising him as Betty Burke, an Irish maid, and escorting him to safety on the Isle of Skye. This daring act of loyalty became immortalized in the traditional Scottish song "The Skye Boat Song."
