
## On This Date

1849 – Governor William Rowan proclaimed that the seat of government for the province of Canada would be moved to Toronto from Montreal, after the Parliament Buildings in Montreal were burned down by mobs protesting the Rebellion Losses Bill.

1964 – Gordie Howe of the Detroit Red Wings scored his 627th career goal, becoming the NHL's all-time leading goal scorer at the time—including playoff goals.

1982 – Jean Drapeau was elected to his eighth term as mayor of Montreal, securing 48 percent of the popular vote. Despite a drop in support from previous elections, his Civic Party won 39 of 57 council seats, maintaining control of city hall.
