1982 – The Canada Act (also known as the Constitution Act, 1982) was passed by the Canadian Parliament. This legislation gave Canada complete control over its laws and amendments, solidifying its independence from the United Kingdom.

1988 – Canadian figure skater Kurt Browning became the first person to successfully land a quadruple jump in competition, at the World Championships in Budapest, Hungary.
