At this time, I would like to reflect on how fortunate we are at the Society to have families, caregivers, volunteers, staff and donors who are so dedicated to our goal of alleviating the personal and social consequences of Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia.

Since 1983, we have collaborated with people and organizations at many levels to change what it means to have Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia. We have worked with people living in Peel, with physicians, hospitals, other organizations, and the government. To date, Alzheimer Society Peel has forwarded over \$1.38 Million dollars to research, and we are proud to have played a significant role in this progress by funding ground-breaking research. Equally important is our role in provision of information and support to those living with the disease.

It is a privilege for me as President of the Society's Board of Directors to work with those who have supported people whose lives have been touched by Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia. In the last year alone, this was over 32,000 people in the Region of Peel.


