Our programs offer supervised activities in a comforting, home-like setting, with professional staff experienced in dementia care ensuring a safe, structured, and stimulating environment.

In-Home & Community Recreational and Support Programs

We provide a range of support services tailored to individuals living with dementia and their families, including support groups where personal experiences are shared, fostering a sense of community and empowerment. Additionally, our innovative programs, both community-based and in-home, promote physical, mental, and emotional wellness year-round for both individuals with dementia and their care partners.

Dementia Education
