**Title of position: Meaningful Moments Activation Volunteer (recruiting up to 7 volunteers in the City of Thunder Bay)**

Meaningful Moments Activation is a volunteer-based initiative aimed at reducing isolation and enhancing the quality of life for individuals living with Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia by providing consistent, in-home social interaction and cognitive stimulation. Through regular visits, volunteers engage clients in meaningful activities such as games, puzzles, and friendly conversation to foster emotional well-being, encourage cognitive engagement, and offer reliable companionship on a consistent schedule.

**Reporting to:**

Direct support from the Volunteer Coordinator

**Tasks/Responsibilities:**

- To ensure that the person with dementia is safe and feels as secure and content as possible.
- Uphold confidentiality and privacy according to PHIPA legislation.
- To provide enriching recreational and social experiences for the person living with dementia, considering the needs of that person.
- Complete required training.
- Report hours and document visits as directed by the volunteer coordinator.
- Complete an incident report immediately following an incident of concern
- Respect and adhere to all policies and procedures of the Alzheimer Society.

**Qualifications:**

- Experience working with someone living with dementia.
- Ability to adapt to the needs of the person with dementia
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to accept direction and to ask for help when needed.
- Reliable and dependable
- Empathetic and non-judgmental
- Comfortable initiating conversations and working 1 to 1 with clients
